



Totus Tuus – (Latin for “Totally Yours”) is a Catholic youth program dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith through catechesis, evangelization, Christian witness, and Eucharistic worship. The goal of **Totus Tuus** is to help young people grow in the understanding of, and strengthen their faith in, Jesus Christ.

What is Totus Tuus?

Five essential elements to the Totus Tuus program:

1. Proclamation of the Gospel – to arouse faith
2. Apologetics – examination of the reasons for our beliefs
3. Christian Witness – an experience of Christian living
4. Celebration of the Sacraments – especially Holy Eucharist and Confession
5. Active Witness of the Missionary Nature of the Catholic Church

Grade School Program

For Catholic children going into **1st through 6th grades**. The program strives to:

- < **Help** students be clear and consistent in their faith
- < **Show** the children that the humble yet courageous seeking of all believers is to be based upon the Word of God.

Program for Secondary Students, Totus Tuus Primetime

For Catholic youth going into **7th through 12th grades**, and includes inclusive instruction, large and small group discussions, quiet meditation, skits, subject related activities, and prayer and fellowship.

Jr./Sr. High School Program meets 7:30 – 9:15 p.m. (Sunday/Thursday from 6:30 – 9 pm participants will attend the 7:30 pm Mass on Sunday)
